



2008 JENŐ ÁDÁM SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

The purpose of the Jenő Ádám Scholarship is to provide partial funding to OAKE members toward study at OAKE-endorsed Kodály certification programs in the United States and Hungary.

The Jenő Ádám Scholarship does not examine financial need as criteria for awards. Individuals may apply for more than one scholarship from OAKE, but will only be eligible for one award any given year, as determined by the Scholarship Committee.

PREREQUISITES

- Be a current OAKE member. (Please **send a copy of your membership card** with your completed application. Do not wait until the deadline to assure that membership is up-to-date or that you can find your membership card.)
- Must have completed at least Level I at an OAKE-endorsed Kodály training program.
- Seek training at an OAKE-endorsed Kodály training program in the U.S. or in Hungary at either the Liszt Academy in Budapest or the Kodály Pedagogical Institute of Music in Kecskemét. Qualifying study must be in Level II, Level III, continuing study in Hungary, or Masters work with Kodály emphasis.
- Currently teach music or be actively involved in music education.
- Exhibit a strong desire to study the Kodály concept.

DIRECTIONS

1. Complete page two (2) of this application
2. Attach a one 8.5 x 11 inch page essay (without any identifying information within the body of the essay) **double spaced**, with Times New Roman 12 point type, that meets the following points:
 - a. Use the third page of this application or if you create your own, type "Jenő Ádám Scholarship Application Essay" in upper left-hand corner and type your name in the upper right-hand corner.
 - b. Describe your interest in studying the Kodály concept.
 - c. Describe your role in music education as you see it 5 years from now as justification for OAKE's investment in your education.
 - d. Do not include any identifying information within your essay.
3. Ask two professional references to submit a recommendation form on your behalf. At least **ONE** recommendation **must** come from a Kodály pedagogy instructor.

**** IMPORTANT ****

Only applications which follow these stated requirements by the deadline will be considered. Scholarship recipients will be asked to write a *Reflection* of their experience for possible inclusion in the **OAKE KODALY ENVOY**.
